

POTENTIAL ADOPTERS



Canine Parvovirus or "parvo" is extremely contagious between dogs and can be fatal, even with aggressive, early diagnosis and treatment. A dog can become infected by parvovirus by encountering the virus through contaminated surfaces including shoes, rugs, bedding, clothing, and even soil or grass.

SYMPTOMS

Dogs can be harboring parvovirus for days before showing any symptoms. Parvo symptoms include diarrhea, bloody diarrhea, fever, decreased activity level, vomiting, abdominal pain, and not wanting to eat. Unvaccinated adult dogs and puppies who have been in contact with parvovirus or are showing symptoms of parvovirus should be seen by a veterinarian and tested immediately.

PREVENTION

The easiest way to prevent Canine Parvovirus is through regular immunizations. Unvaccinated dogs or puppies who have not completed their full series of booster immunizations, should avoid high-traffic areas such as dog parks or pet stores and should not socialize with dogs outside of their household. Prevention is easy but treatment is difficult and costly, costing up to \$2000 at some clinics.

TREATMENT

KC Pet Project's Parvo Program offers treatment on a case-by-case basis. Dogs who enter our program are quarantined and treated in our Parvo Ward for up to 14 days. The average cost of treatment is \$500 and must be paid in full prior to, or at the time of reclaim. Pets not reclaimed within 24 hours of completing treatment will become the property of KC Pet Project.

While we cannot guarantee the pet's survival, our team will do everything we can to achieve the best outcome. If you wish to reclaim your pet after treatment, please contact our Pet Support Center team immediately.

El parvovirus canino o "parvo" es extremadamente contagioso entre perros y puede ser fatal, incluso con un diagnóstico y tratamiento precoces y agresivos. Un perro puede infectarse por parvovirus al encontrar el virus a través de superficies contaminadas, como zapatos, alfombras, ropa de cama, ropa e incluso tierra o césped.

SINTOMAS

Los perros pueden albergar parvovirus durante días antes de mostrar cualquier síntoma. Los síntomas del paro cardíaco incluyen diarrea, diarrea con sangre, fiebre, disminución del nivel de actividad, vómitos, dolor abdominal y no querer comer. Los perros adultos y cachorros no vacunados que hayan estado en contacto con parvovirus o que presenten síntomas de parvovirus deben ser examinados por un veterinario y examinados de inmediato.

PREVENCIÓN

La forma más sencilla de prevenir el parvovirus canino es mediante vacunas periódicas. Los perros o cachorros no vacunados que no hayan completado su serie completa de vacunas de refuerzo deben evitar las áreas de mucho tráfico, como parques para perros o tiendas de mascotas, y no deben socializar con perros fuera de su hogar. La prevención es fácil, pero el tratamiento es difícil y costoso, con un costo de hasta \$ 2000 en algunas clínicas.

TRATAMIENTO

El programa Parvo de KC Pet Project ofrece tratamiento caso por caso. Los perros que ingresan a nuestro programa son puestos en cuarentena y tratados en nuestra sala de parvo por 14 días. El costo promedio del tratamiento es de \$500 y debe pagarse en su totalidad antes o en el momento de la reclamación. Las mascotas que no se recuperan dentro de las 24 horas posteriores a la finalización del tratamiento pasarán a ser propiedad de KC Pet Project.

No podemos garantizar la supervivencia de la mascota, nuestro equipo hará todo lo posible para lograr el mejor resultado. Si desea recuperar a su mascota después del tratamiento, comuníquese con nuestro equipo del Centro de asistencia para mascotas de inmediato.



5 PASOS A HACE CUANDO UNA MASCOTA ESTÁ PERDIDA

1. CAMINE EL VECINDARIO

Camine el vecindario donde desapareció su mascota y hable con vecinos, carteros y niños jugando para investigar si alguien ha visto su mascota.

2. PUBLIQUE EN NEXTDOOR

Cree un mensaje en su vecindario app de Nextdoor, NextDoor.com

3. BUSQUE SITIOS PERDIDAS Y ENCONTRADAS DE LA RED Visite KCPetProject.org/LostPets y utilice los enlaces para acceder a sitios varios de mascotas perdidas y encontradas, grupos de media social y presente un informe de mascotas perdidas.

4. VISITE EL CAMPUS DE KC POR CUIDAD DE ANIMAL

Venga en persona al campus de KC por cuidado de animal para chequear si su mascota ha sido traído. Obtenga una lista de otros albergues locales para visitar. Chequear mascotas perdidas en los sitios de la red, además de Facebook.com/KCPetProjectLostFound cada un par horas para ver animales nuevos.

5. CREATE POSTERS

Cree carteles usando cartulina fluorescente para colgar en las carteleras vecindarios y en las esquinas de tráfico; cree folletos para repartir en su vecindario. Asegúrese incluir una foto muy clara y el numero de contacto.

COSAS IMPORTANTES PARA RECORDAR

- Si su mascota perdida tiene un microchip, contacte la compañía del microchip y asegúrese que su información de Contacto esta realizado y reporte su mascota como perdida
- Actúe inmediatamente para corre la voz.
- Visite sus albergues locales.
- Sea diligente.

5 PASOS A HACER CUANDO ENCUENTRA UNA MASCOTA

1. COMPRUEBE POR IDENTIFICACION

Compruebe por un collar y etiqueta. Algunas mascotas tienen un collar cosió con el número de teléfono.

2. SAOUE UNA FOTO

Publica una foto de la mascota perdida en NextDoor.com, su grupo de media social de su vecindario y su cuenta de media social. La mayoría de las mascotas perdidas se quedan cerca de la casa.

3. VAYA A LA CLÍNICA DE VETERINARIO CERCANO

Lleve la mascota a la clínica veterinario para comprobar por un microchip.

4. COMPLETE UN INFORME DE MASCOTAS FNCONTRADAS

Complete un informe a KCPetProject.org/foundpet

5. CREE UN FOLLETO DE LA MASCOTA ENCONTRADA

Cree un folleto de la mascota para publicar en media socia y alrededor un vecindario.
