EDUCATION PAVILION

Our campus will feature a signature Education Pavilion, where the very heart of the region's human-to-animal welfare educational efforts will take place. This Pavilion, which will feature glass walls and a patio/fire pit overlooking the Pond and Swope Park, will host the broadest range of activities -- including community educational events for children and adults, board meetings, birthday parties, volunteer orientations and classes, special events and a great deal more. This opportunity includes naming rights on the exterior main Campus entry.

ADOPTION CENTER LOBBY ATRIUM

As you enter the grand Adoption Center Lobby, our 25,000+ visitors each year will be greeted by adoptable pets, a lot of glass showcasing beautiful views of Swope Park entry to the retail store, technology showing our daily events, specials, etc. and so much more. Support includes signage in the entrance to the lobby.

VETERINARY CARE CENTER

The state of the art Veterinary Care Center will provide care to over 10,000 shelter pets every year. Additionally, low-cost public veterinary services will be provided to thousands of additional pets. Signage on the front of the Veterinary Care Center and throughout the clinic to be included.

ANIMAL SERVICES/ADMISSIONS/LOST & FOUND

Thousands of visitors come to the shelter to utilize our animal services including stray animal drop-off, Animal Field Service inquires, people looking for lost pets, and owner relinquishments. Signage on the outside of the building included and throughout Admissions department.

SWOPE PARK EDUCATION AND EVENT DECK (SOLD) \$750,000

An event deck located just off of the Education Pavilion and the Adoption Center, this will overlook the beautiful setting of Swope Park and will be used for many functions, including after-hours events.

WALKING PATHS

Volunteers and staff will walk all of the dogs of KC Pet Project on walking paths located behind the campus. There will be multiple paths with miles of trails with cute signage throughout and around the pond recognizing our donor and opportunities for training with our pets.

ARRIVAL PLAZA

Near the Adoption Center entrance, there will be a lovely outdoor plaza area for seating for the coffee shop, volunteers, adopters and more.

PLAY YARD PLAZA

Every available dog gets to have play time every day at KC Pet Project as part of their Canine Playgroup Program. These play yards will be utilized by thousands of adopters meeting new pets. Signage included in Play Yard Plaza.

CAMPUS POND

A pond centered on the east side of the campus where the walking paths will all lead to. Signage included at the pond.

CATIO

Outdoor catio spaces will be located on the front of the adoption center that will give our cats outdoor time for enrichment. Signage will be included on the exterior of the catio space.

FARM ANIMALS BUILDING

Out building behind the shelter where adoptable farm animals will be housed including chickens, goats, pigs, ducks, and so many more. Signage including on the front of the building and throughout.

INTERIOR OPPORTUNITIES

CAT ADOPTION CENTER

The cat adoption center entrance is viewed immediately upon entering the lobby of the shelter. This opportunity will support thousands of cats who look for homes each year. Signage is included upon entry of the cat adoption area.

DOG DISTRICTS #1, 2 & 3 (#1 SOLD) 3 DISTRICTS AT \$250,000 EACH

The first three canine holding rooms in the Adoption Center. Each district will house 15 dogs, impacting up to 1,000 dogs each year. Signage on the entry of each dog district to be included.

DOG DISTRICT #4: SENIOR LOVE CLUB

This room will be a dedicated space for the senior dogs in the shelter. This will house 15 dogs, impacting up to 500 dogs each year. Signage on the entry of dog district to be included.

DOG DISTRICT #5: PUPPIES/SMALL DOGS (SOLD) \$250,000

This dog rooms is the third canine animal room and will house approximately 12 small dogs and puppies in a room. This is a very high traffic area as there is a lot of interest in small dogs and puppies. Signage included in entry of dog room.

DOG DISTRICTS 6 & 7: STRAY HOLDING

These dog holding rooms and will house at least 15 dogs in each room, impacting up to 1,000 dogs each year. This room will hold mainly dogs that are on stray hold or unavailable for adoption. Signage is included in entry.

INDOOR PLAY ROOM

Immediately off of the dog adoption center, this indoor space will be used for meet n' greets with potential pets, indoor play time and enrichment with shelter dogs, classes for the public and volunteers and so much more. Signage included in this space.

CAT ROAMING ROOMS (LARGE)

Play rooms for cats at KC Pet Project. These two rooms will be surrounded by glass for adopters to view the kitties looking for homes and will be able to be seen through the retail store.

CAT ROAMING ROOMS (SMALL) 3 ROOMS (TWO SOLD) AT \$40,000 EACH

Three rooms will feature housing areas for several cats and each will have access to the Catios, where the cats can have some outdoor time in an enclosed space.

DISTRICTS 8 & 9: QUARANTINE HOUSING

\$100,000 EACH

These canine holding rooms will house at least 15 dogs in each room, impacting up to 1,000 dogs each year. This room will hold mainly dogs that are on stray hold, quarantine, unavailable for adoption. Though off of the public corridor, thousands of visitors will view this room each year and signage is included in entry.

DOG MEET N' GREET ROOMS 6 ROOMS (THREE SOLD) AT \$100,000 EACH

There will be five meet n' greet rooms in the dog adoption center where families will meet and interact with pets they hope to adopt. Signage included in the meet n' greet space.

CAT MEET N' GREET ROOMS 2 ROOMS (ONE SOLD) AT \$100,000 EACH

There will be two meet n' greet rooms in the cat adoption center where families will meet and interact with pets they hope to adopt. Signage included in meet n' greet space.

VOLUNTEER CENTER

Located on of the main public corridor, this will be the gathering place for all of the campus volunteers. They will check in here, there will be a work space for groups, and a kitchenette. Thousands of volunteers annually will use this area and signage will be included on

4 ROOMS (FOUR SOLD) AT \$50,000 EACH

These suites will house featured dogs looking for homes at the shelter. They will be viewed upon entering the adoption center, next to the retail store, and near the dog districts. Signage to be included in the suite.

VETERINARY EXAM ROOMS 3 ROOMS (TWO SOLD) AT \$25,000 EACH

These exam rooms will be located in the Veterinary Care Center and will be used by the public every day for appointments, wellness visits, and other services. They will be fear-free rooms to make the animals visiting the veterinary center more comfortable.
