As the Kansas City area emerged from stay-at-home orders due to COVID-19, KC Pet Project launched its *Keep 'Em Together, KC* program to assist the many families who will be housing and food insecure for many months to come. Providing resources to our community is the best way to keep families and their pets together and to prevent pets from being needlessly relinquished.

In June, KC Pet Project created a new position and welcomed a director of community services to the team to oversee *Keep 'Em Together, KC* initiatives. *Keep 'Em Together, KC* will create a true safety net for pets by providing emergency support programs for pet owners. By building partnerships with local human services organizations, we will be able to offer options for temporary boarding, access to basic medical care, pet food assistance, microchipping, vaccinations and more for income-insecure families.

Recently, a young woman called KC Pet Project in tears after she was notified by her apartment complex that new management was taking over and no pets would be allowed. She needed to move quickly and had nowhere to turn for help. Heartbroken, she made an appointment to relinquish her beloved dog. The team at KC Pet Project sought out a temporary foster home for her dog, and just before her appointment, a friend agreed to care for her dog for a month so she could find a new apartment. She was so grateful for KC Pet Project's compassionate help. This is exactly what we want *Keep 'Em Together, KC* initiatives to do — help people who love their pets keep their pets.


